

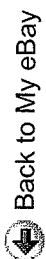

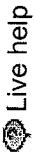



Vehicle Description

This is really an exceptional car. I purchased it from the original owner who purchased the car new in the Bay area at Martin-Johnson Porsche Audi in Oakland. I have all the original documentation, bill of sale, window sticker, receipts, even the temporary California paper license plate etc...I have every piece of collectible 914 sales literature from 1973, it is a treasure trove.

This is the nicest original 914 I have ever seen. Remember you can restore a car but it is only original once. This one is like a time machine. (Take a look at the bumper sticker on the rear bumper, remember those days?)

The original owner used the car for national Porsche rallies and the car has been in the PCA since it was new in 1973. The car does not have nor has it ever had any rust at all. When I purchased it was leaking some oil. I think it was because it had been sitting covered in his garage for a few years. My Porsche mechanic pulled the motor and replaced all leaking seals and gaskets. The transmission was completely examined, the clutch was replaced and the motor was

completely examined and given a clean bill of health.

The car has the optional appearance group. In some places it is called the 914S. The center console with gauge package and the leather wrapped steering wheel, and the Fuchs aluminum wheels. The J Tronic fuel injection is performing well and the suspension is tight. The 5 original fuchs wheels are in beautiful condition. The 4 tires on the car are Yokohamas in nearly new condition.

This car is done in Ravena green with the black basketweave interior and the original cocoa floor mats. It is remarkable.

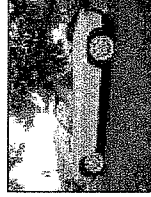
I just spend over \$5,000.00 getting this car in shape for the new owner. I want the car to go to someone who knows what it is and treats it with TLC. This may be the nicest original 914 in the country. (I know that sounds crazy but I have to tell you how wonderful this 914 really is)

This is a car that you can take a great deal of pride in. It is ready to drive or to show. I regret having to sell but a change in finances makes it impossible to keep. The interior is in beautiful shape with the exception of a small tear on the driver's side seat cushion, easy to replace. There is a period Johnson CB radio in the car that the owner used for rallies.

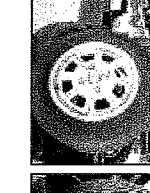
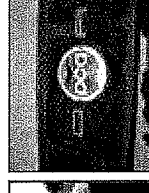
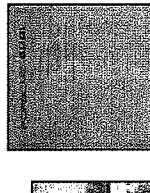
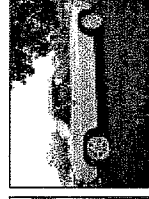
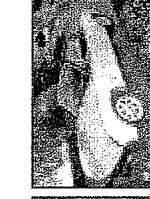
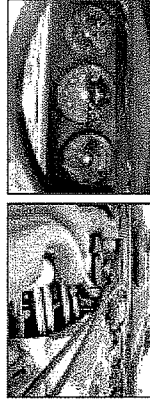
There is also a front end bra included as well as an indoor car cover that is custom fit for the car. You will not be disappointed in any aspect of this car it is a very rare and beautiful find.

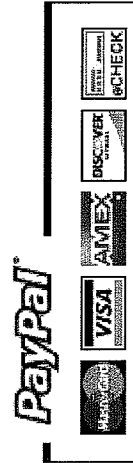
