Modified Wheel Fastening Bolts

Concerns:

Wheel fastening bolts have been modified.

Information:

The bolts previously used for wheel mounting will be replaced by new bolts with an height of 14.5 mm (previously 16.5 mm).

This results in a weight reduction in un-sprung mass.

The wheel bolt for anti-theft protection is not affected by this.

996 361 203 90 Previous/no longer available after existing supplies are used up

Spare Parts Requirements

Only wheel fastening bolts with the same measurement of 16.5 mm or 14.5 mm may be installed on a wheel. After using up the stock of previous bolts with 16.5 mm measurement, the entire bolt set must be replaced per wheel when requiring spare parts on vehicles with the previous fastening bolts.

Note: A mixed configuration results in increased wheel imbalance.
